3	SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF 10-YEAR LIMITATION ON COL-
4	LECTION OF NONTAX DEBT BY ADMINISTRA-
5	TIVE OFFSET.
6	Section 3716(e) of title 31, United States Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	"(e) This section—
9	"(1) applies to a claim under this subchapter
10	regardless of the period it has been outstanding; and

1 "(2) does not apply when a statute explicitly 2 prohibits using administrative offset or setoff to col-3 lect the claim or type of claim involved.".
