To amend title 31, United States Code, to eliminate the 10-year limitation on the collection of nontax debt.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF 10-YEAR LIMITATION ON COL-**
4 **LECTION OF NONTAX DEBT BY ADMINISTRA-**
5 **TIVE OFFSET.**

6 Section 3716(e) of title 31, United States Code, is
7 amended to read as follows:

8 “(e) This section—

9 “(1) applies to a claim under this subchapter
10 regardless of the period it has been outstanding; and

1 “(2) does not apply when a statute explicitly
2 prohibits using administrative offset or setoff to col-
3 lect the claim or type of claim involved.”.
