AN ACTTo authorize appropriations for the National Fish and
Wildlife Foundation, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “National Fish and
5 Wildlife Foundation Reauthorization Act of 2005”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

7 Section 10(a)(1) of the National Fish and Wildlife
8 Foundation Establishment Act (16 U.S.C. 3709(a)(1)) is

1 amended by striking “fiscal years 2001 through 2005”
2 and inserting “fiscal years 2006 through 2010”.

3 **SEC. 3. APPLICATION OF NOTICE REQUIREMENT LIMITED**
4 **TO GRANTS MADE WITH FEDERAL FUNDS.**

5 Section 4(i) of the National Fish and Wildlife Foun-
6 dation Establishment Act (16 U.S.C. 3703(i)) is amended
7 by striking “grant of funds” and inserting “grant of Fed-
8 eral funds in an amount greater than \$10,000”.

9 **SEC. 4. CLARIFICATION OF AUTHORITY TO USE FEDERAL**
10 **FUNDS TO MATCH CONTRIBUTIONS MADE TO**
11 **RECIPIENTS OF NATIONAL FISH AND WILD-**
12 **LIFE FOUNDATION GRANTS.**

13 Section 10(a)(3) of the National Fish and Wildlife
14 Foundation Establishment Act (16 U.S.C. 3709(a)(3)) is
15 amended by inserting “, or to a recipient of a grant pro-
16 vided by the Foundation,” after “made to the Founda-
17 tion”.

18 **SEC. 5. REPEAL.**

19 Effective September 30, 2015, section 10(a)(1) of the
20 National Fish and Wildlife Foundation Establishment Act
21 (16 U.S.C. 3709(a)(1)) is hereby repealed.
