- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.

- 2 (a) In General.—The building and structure de-
- 3 scribed in subsection (b) shall be known and designated
- 4 as the "Justin W. Williams United States Attorney's
- 5 Building".
- 6 (b) Description.—The building and structure to be
- 7 designated under subsection (a) is that portion of the Fed-
- 8 eral building located at 2100 Jamieson Avenue, in Alexan-
- 9 dria, Virginia, that is attached to the Federal building's
- 10 main tower structure, described as A-Wing in the architec-
- 11 tural plans, and currently occupied by the Office of the
- 12 United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Vir-
- 13 ginia, Alexandria Division.

14 SEC. 2. REFERENCES.

- 15 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
- 16 paper, or other record of the United States to the building
- 17 and structure described in section 1(b) shall be deemed
- 18 to be a reference to the "Justin W. Williams United States
- 19 Attorney's Building".

20 SEC. 3. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.

- There are authorized to be appropriated such sums
- 22 as may be necessary for appropriate identifying designa-
- 23 tions to be affixed to the building and structure described
- 24 in section 1(b) and for an appropriate plaque reflecting
- 25 the designation and honoring Justin W. Williams and his

- 1 service to the Nation to be affixed to or displayed in such
- 2 building and structure.
