A BILL

To return general aviation to Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Return of General
- 5 Aviation to Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport
- 6 Act of 2005".

SEC. 2. AIR CHARTER AND GENERAL AVIATION OPER-
ATIONS AT RONALD REAGAN WASHINGTON
NATIONAL AIRPORT.
Notwithstanding any law, regulation, or agency policy
or directive that has the effect of generally prohibiting
general aviation aircraft from landing at Ronald Reagan
Washington National Airport, not later than 180 days
after the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of
Transportation, acting through the Federal Aviation Ad-
ministration, in consultation with the Secretary of Home-
land Security, shall permit the resumption of non-
scheduled, commercial air carrier air charter and general
aviation operations at Ronald Reagan Washington Na-
tional Airport.
