2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HONORABLE JUDGE GEORGE N. LEIGHTON**
4 **POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 695 Pleasant Street in New Bed-
7 ford, Massachusetts, shall be known and designated as the

1 “Honorable Judge George N. Leighton Post Office Build-
2 ing”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Honorable Judge
7 George N. Leighton Post Office Building”.
