	" 9902.04.57 Crotonaldehyde (2-butenaldehyde) (CAS No. 4170–30–3) (provided for in subheading 2912.19.50) Free No change No change On or before 12/31/2008 ".

8 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by

9 subsection (a) apply to articles entered, or withdrawn from

- 1 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
- 2 the date of the enactment of this Act.
