3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "National Law Enforce-
- 5 ment Officers Memorial Maintenance Fund Act of 2005".

1SEC. 2. COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT WITH RESPECT TO NA-2TIONAL LAW ENFORCEMENT MEMORIAL3MAINTENANCE FUND.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 201 of Public Law 104–
5 329 is amended by adding at the end the following new
6 subsection:

7 "(d) Cooperative Agreement.—

8 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Effective on and after the 9 date of the enactment of the National Law Enforce-10 ment Memorial Maintenance Fund Act of 2005, the 11 following applies, notwithstanding other provisions of 12 this Act:

"(A) The Secretary of the Interior, acting 13 14 through the National Park Service, shall enter 15 into a cooperative agreement with the National 16 Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Fund, 17 Inc., a nonprofit corporation incorporated under 18 the laws of the District of Columbia, to carry 19 out the purposes of the Fund as described in 20 subsection (b).

21 "(B) In accordance with the terms of such
22 agreement, the Secretary shall transfer all
23 amounts in the Fund to the Corporation.

24 "(2) DEFINITIONS.—For purposes of this sub25 section—

1	"(A) the term 'Corporation' means the Na-
2	tional Law Enforcement Officers Memorial
3	Fund, Inc; and
4	"(B) the term 'Secretary' means the Sec-
5	retary of the Interior.".
6	(b) Purposes of Fund.—Section 201(b) of Public
7	Law 104–329 is amended—
8	(1) in paragraph (3), by inserting "and" after
9	the semicolon;
10	(2) by striking paragraphs (4) , (6) , and (7) ,
11	and redesignating paragraph (5) as paragraph (4) ;
12	and
13	(3) in paragraph (4) (as so redesignated), by
14	striking the semicolon and inserting a period.
