9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1201(b) of the Omnibus
10 Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 is amended

by inserting after "determines that a public safety officer
 has" the following: ", whether before, on, or after the date
 of the enactment of this Act,".

4 (b) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub5 section (a) applies to any public safety officer alive on or
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
