Mr. BRADY of Texas introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To provide for the liquidation or reliquidation of certain
drawback claims.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIQUIDATION OR RELIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN**
4 **DRAWBACK CLAIMS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
6 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
7 vision of law, the Bureau of Customs and Border Protec-
8 tion shall, not later than 90 days after the date of the
9 enactment of this Act, liquidate or reliquidate the draw-
10 back claims, as filed, that are described in subsection (c).

1 (b) PAYMENT OF AMOUNTS DUE.—Any amounts due
 2 pursuant to the liquidation or reliquidation of the claims
 3 described in subsection (c) shall be paid not later than
 4 90 days after the date of such liquidation or reliquidation.

5 (c) DRAWBACK CLAIMS.—The drawback claims re-
 6 ferred to in subsection (a) are the following:
