- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. LIQUIDATION OR RELIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN
- 4 DRAWBACK CLAIMS.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
- 6 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
- 7 vision of law, the Bureau of Customs and Border Protec-
- 8 tion shall, not later than 90 days after the date of the
- 9 enactment of this Act, liquidate or reliquidate the draw-
- 10 back claims, as filed, that are described in subsection (c).

- 1 (b) Payment of Amounts Due.—Any amounts due
- 2 pursuant to the liquidation or reliquidation of the claims
- 3 described in subsection (c) shall be paid not later than
- 4 90 days after the date of such liquidation or reliquidation.
