Mr. MICA introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

## A BILL

To direct the Administrator of General Services to take such action as may be necessary to have the Federal Trade Commission vacate the building located at 600 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, in the District of Columbia and to make that building available for occupancy by the National Gallery of Art.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. NATIONAL GALLERY OF ART.**

4       (a) LOCATION.—Not later than December 31, 2012,  
5       the Administrator of General Services shall take such ac-  
6       tion as may be necessary to—

1           (1) have the Federal Trade Commission vacate  
2           the building located at 600 Pennsylvania Avenue,  
3           NW, in the District of Columbia;

4           (2) make that building available for occupancy  
5           by the National Gallery of Art; and

6           (3) relocate the Federal Trade Commission into  
7           another appropriate building in a location selected in  
8           consultation with the Commission.

9           (b) RECONSTRUCTION.—The Administrator shall re-  
10          construct the building referred to in subsection (a)(1) to  
11          house and exhibit works of art and carry administrative  
12          functions, subject to the requirements of the Director of  
13          the National Gallery of Art.

14          (c) DESIGNATION.—Beginning on the date that the  
15          National Gallery of Art takes occupancy of the building  
16          referred to in subsection (a)(1)—

17               (1) the building shall be known and designated  
18               as the “National Gallery of Art”; and

19               (2) any reference in a law, map, regulation,  
20               document, paper, or other record of the United  
21               States to the building shall be deemed to be a ref-  
22               erence to the “National Gallery of Art”.
