## A BILL

### SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF DISCRETION TO ORDER EXPE-2 DITED REMOVAL. 3 Section 235(b)(1)(A)(iii)(I) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1225(b)(1)(A)(iii)(I)) is amend-4 5 ed to read as follows: 6 "(I) IN GENERAL.—The Sec-7 retary of Homeland Security shall 8 apply clauses (i) and (ii) of this sub-9 paragraph to all aliens described in 10 subclause (II), except that if the Sec-11 retary, after consulting with appro-12 priate Federal, State, or local law en-13 forcement agencies, determines that 14 the alien will be detained under the 15 authority of such an agency, the Sec-16 retary may not remove the alien until 17 such detention terminates.". 18 SEC. 2. RESIDENTIAL MORTGAGES PROHIBITED FOR 19 ALIENS RESIDING IN THE UNITED STATES 20 UNLAWFULLY. 21 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 2 of the Truth in Lend-22 ing Act (15 U.S.C. 1631 et seq.) is amended by adding
