A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to allow qualifying children's hospitals to participate in the 340B drug discount program.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. ALLOWING QUALIFYING CHILDREN'S HOSPITALS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 340B DRUG

DISCOUNT PROGRAM.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 340B(a)(4)(L) of the
Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 256b(a)(4)(L)) is
amended—

(1) by inserting after "A subsection (d) hospital

(as defined in section 1886(d)(1)(B) of the Social

- 1 Security Act)" the following: "or a children's hospital described in section 1886(d)(1)(B)(iii) of such
- 3 Act"; and
- 4 (2) in clause (ii), by inserting "or, in the case 5 of such a children's hospital, as would be determined 6 under such section if the hospital were such a sub-7 section (d) hospital" after "section 1886(d)(5)(F) of
- 7 section (d) hospital" after "section 1886(d)(5)(F) of
- 8 the Social Security Act".
- 9 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 10 subsection (a) shall apply to drugs purchased on or after
- 11 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
