3 **SECTION 1. STATE SENATOR VERDA WELCOME AND DR.**

4 **HENRY WELCOME POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 3000 Homewood Avenue in Bal-
7 timore, Maryland, shall be known and designated as the

1 “State Senator Verda Welcome and Dr. Henry Welcome
2 Post Office Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “State Senator Verda
7 Welcome and Dr. Henry Welcome Post Office Building”.
