A BILL

To temporarily increase the borrowing authority of the Federal Emergency Management Agency for carrying out the national flood insurance program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “National Flood Insur-
3 ance Program Further Enhanced Borrowing Authority
4 Act of 2005”.

5 **SEC. 2. INCREASE IN BORROWING AUTHORITY.**

6 The first sentence of subsection (a) of section 1309
7 of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
8 4016(a)), as amended by the National Flood Insurance
9 Program Enhanced Borrowing Authority Act of 2005
10 (Public Law 109–65; 119 Stat. 1998), is amended by
11 striking “\$3,500,000,000” and inserting
12 “\$8,500,000,000”.
