 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Chesapeake and Dela-
 - 5 ware Canal Recreation Authorization Act".

1 SEC. 2. INTRACOASTAL WATERWAY.

- 2 (a) AGREEMENTS.—The Secretary of the Army shall
- 3 enter into, with the consent of appropriate local and State
- 4 entities, arrangements, contracts, and leases with public,
- 5 private, and nonprofit entities as may be necessary to
- 6 evaluate, construct, operate, and maintain capital im-
- 7 provements for recreational use of the Intracoastal Water-
- 8 way, Delaware River to Chesapeake Bay, Delaware and
- 9 Maryland (Chesapeake and Delaware Canal) and its re-
- 10 lated facilities, and to provide security for the canal and
- 11 its related facilities.
- 12 (b) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share of the cost
- 13 of capital improvements under this section shall be 50 per-
- 14 cent. Operation and maintenance costs shall be at full
- 15 Federal expense.
- 16 (c) Credit for Design and Construction
- 17 WORK.—The Secretary of the Army shall credit toward
- 18 the non-Federal share of the cost of the project design
- 19 and construction work carried out by the non-Federal in-
- 20 terest before the date of an agreement if the Secretary
- 21 determines that such work is integral to the project.
- 22 (d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
- 23 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
- 24 \$10,000,000. Such sums shall remain available until ex-
- 25 pended.
