A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to provide for certain transportation and subsistence in cases where district courts are holding special sessions as a result of emergency conditions.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSPORTATION AND SUBSISTENCE FOR**
4 **SPECIAL SESSIONS OF DISTRICT COURTS.**

5 (a) TRANSPORTATION AND SUBSISTENCE.—Section
6 141(b) of title 28, United States Code, as added by section
7 2(b) of Public Law 109–63, is amended by adding at the
8 end the following:

1 “(5) If a district court issues an order exercising its
2 authority under paragraph (1), the court shall direct the
3 United States marshal of the district where the court is
4 meeting to furnish transportation and subsistence to the
5 same extent as that provided in sections 4282 and 4285
6 of title 18.”.

7 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
8 are authorized to be appropriated such sums as may be
9 necessary to carry out paragraph (5) of section 141(b) of
10 title 28, United States Code, as added by subsection (a)
11 of this section.

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
