AN ACT

To reauthorize grants for and require applied water supply research regarding the water resources research and technology institutes established under the Water Resources Research Act of 1984.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Water Resources Re-
- 5 search Act Amendments of 2006".
- 6 SEC. 2. WATER RESOURCES RESEARCH ACT AMENDMENTS.
- 7 (a) Scope of Research; Other Activities; Co-
- 8 OPERATION AND COORDINATION.—Section 104(b)(1) of
- 9 the Water Resources Research Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C.
- 10 10303(b)(1)) is amended to read as follows:

1	"(1) plan, conduct, or otherwise arrange for					
2	competent applied and peer reviewed research that					
3	fosters—					
4	"(A) improvements in water supply reli-					
5	ability;					
6	"(B) resolutions of other water problems;					
7	"(C) the entry of new research scientist					
8	engineers, and technicians into water resources					
9	fields; and					
10	"(D) the dissemination of research results					
11	to water managers and the public.".					
12	(b) Evaluation of Water Resources Research					
13	Program.—Section 104(e) of the Water Resources Re					
14	search Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303 (e)) is amended—					
15	(1) by striking "5" and inserting "3"; and					
16	(2) by inserting "at producing measured results					
17	and applied water supply research" after "effective-					
18	ness''.					
19	(c) Authorization of Appropriations.—Section					
20	104(f)(1) of the Water Resources Research Act of 1984					
21	(42 U.S.C. $10303(f)(1)$) is amended to read as follows:					
22	"(1) There is authorized to be appropriated to carry					
23	out this section, to remain available until expended,					
24	\$12,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2007 through 2011.".

3	Nature.—Section 104(g)(1) of the Water Resources Re-
4	search Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303 (g)(1)) is amended
5	by striking " $\$3,000,000$ for fiscal year 2001, $\$4,000,000$
6	for each of fiscal years 2002 and 2003 , and $$6,000,000$
7	for each of fiscal years 2004 and 2005" and inserting the
8	following: "\$6,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2007
9	through 2011".
10	(e) Coordination.—Section 104(h)(2) of the Water
11	Resources Research Act of 1984 (42 U.S.C. 10303(h)(2))
12	is amended—
13	(1) by striking "(2) Report" and inserting
14	"(2) Reports"; and
15	(2) by inserting after the first sentence the fol-
16	lowing: "As part of the annual budget submission to
17	Congress, the Secretary shall also provide a crosscut
18	budget detailing the expenditures on activities listed
19	under subsection (a)(1) and a report which details
20	the level of applied research and the results of the
21	activities authorized by this Act, including potential
22	and actual—
23	"(A) increases in annual water supplies;
24	"(B) increases in annual water yields; and

- 1 "(C) advances in water infrastructure improvements.".
