Mr. ROHRABACHER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1986 to expand the authority of non-Federal interests to levy harbor fees.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That section 208(a) of Water Resources Development Act
4 of 1986 (33 U.S.C. 2236(a)) is amended—

5 (1) by inserting “or container fees” after “ton-
6 nage duties or fees”;

7 (2) in paragraph (1)(A)—

8 (A) by striking “or” at the end of clause

9 (i);

1 (B) by striking “and” at the end of clause
2 (ii) and inserting “or”; and

3 (C) by inserting after clause (ii) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(iii) to finance the cost of construction
6 and operation and maintenance of any infra-
7 structure project for a harbor, including an in-
8 frastructure project outside the boundaries of
9 the harbor if the project is for transportation
10 to, from, or through the harbor; and”;

11 (3) in paragraph (1)(B) by inserting “and secu-
12 rity” after “emergency response”.
