## **AN ACT**

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 100 Pitcher Street in Utica, New York, as the "Captain George A. Wood Post Office Building".

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. CAPTAIN GEORGE A. WOOD POST OFFICE
4 BUILDING.

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 100 Pitcher Street in Utica, New
7 York, shall be known and designated as the "Captain
8 George A. Wood Post Office Building".

(b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
 be deemed to be a reference to the "Captain George A.
 Wood Post Office Building".
