A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PRIVACY AND CIVIL LIBERTIES BOARD BUDG-**
2 **ET REQUEST REQUIREMENT.**

3 Section 1105(a) of title 31, United States Code, is
4 amended by adding at the end the following new para-
5 graph:

6 “(35) a separate statement of the proposed
7 budget authority and budget outlays for the Privacy
8 and Civil Liberties Oversight Board.”.

9 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE**
10 **PRIVACY AND CIVIL LIBERTIES OVERSIGHT**
11 **BOARD.**

12 Section 1061(l) of the Intelligence Reform and Ter-
13 rorism Prevention Act of 2004 (Public Law 108–458; 118
14 Stat. 3688) is amended to read as follows:

15 “(l) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There
16 are authorized to be appropriated \$3,000,000 for fiscal
17 year 2007 and each subsequent fiscal year to carry out
18 this section.”.
