4 This Act may be cited as the "National Heroes Credit

- 8 (a) Credit Rating Protection.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—The Servicemembers Civil
 Relief Act (50 U.S.C. App. 501 et seq.) is amended
 by inserting at the end of title I the following new
 section:

5 "SEC. 110. PROTECTION OF CREDIT RATINGS OF PERSONS 6 ACTIVATED FOR MILITARY SERVICE.

7 "(a) REQUIREMENTS OF NOTATION OF DELINQUENT 8 OR SLOW PAYMENT DUE TO MILITARY SERVICE.—Any 9 person or entity engaged in the practice of assembling or 10 evaluating consumer credit information that receives from a creditor a negative report of nonpayment or late pay-11 12 ment with respect to a qualifying account of a person in 13 military service shall enter with that negative report a notation that the account is delinquent or paid slowly due 14 15 to military service.

16 "(b) NEGATIVE INFORMATION TO BE DIS17 REGARDED.—Any future potential creditor of such person
18 who receives a credit report that includes a notation re19 quired by subsection (a) shall disregard any negative in20 formation so noted in the credit report.

"(c) QUALIFYING ACCOUNTS.—For purposes of this
section, a qualifying account is an account that was
opened by a person in military service before the date on
which that person entered that period of military service,

but only with respect to obligations incurred before such
 date.".

3 (2) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of con-4 tents in section 1(b) of such Act is amended by in-5 serting after the item relating to section 109 the fol-6 lowing new item: "Sec. 110. Protection of credit ratings of persons activated for military service". 7 (b) **EFFECTIVE** DATE.—Section 110 of the 8 Servicemembers Civil Relief Act, as added by subsection (a), shall apply with respect to a period of military service 9 10 (as defined in such Act) that is being performed by a person on the date of the enactment of this Act or to which 11 12 a person is ordered on or after such date.
