1 "(4) The distribution of any handbill, pamphlet, 2 leaflet, or other written or printed matter other than 3 a program distributed as part of a funeral or memo-4 rial service or ceremony.". 5 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding 6 7 at the end the following new item: "2413. PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF PROHIBITION ON UN-9 APPROVED DEMONSTRATIONS AT CEME-10 TERIES UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE NA-11 TIONAL CEMETERY ADMINISTRATION AND AT 12 **ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY.** 13 (a) PENALTY.—Chapter 67 of title 18, United States 14 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new 15 section: 16 "§ 1387. Demonstrations at cemeteries under the con-17 trol of National Cemetery Administration 18 and at Arlington National Cemetery 19 "Whoever violates section 2413 of title 38 shall be 20 fined under this title, imprisoned for not more than one year, or both.". 21 22 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding 23 at the end the following new item: 24

"1387. Demonstrations at cemeteries under the control of National Cemetery Administration and at Arlington National Cemetery.".
