3 **SECTION 1. MORRIS W. MILTON POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 1750 16th Street South in St.
6 Petersburg, Florida, shall be known and designated as the
7 “Morris W. Milton Post Office”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Morris W. Milton Post
3 Office”.
