## A BILL

To exempt persons with disabilities from the prohibition against providing section 8 rental assistance to college students.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES**  
2 **FROM SECTION 8 RENTAL ASSISTANCE PRO-**  
3 **HIBITION.**

4 Subsection (a) of section 327 of Public Law 109–115  
5 (119 Stat. 2466) is amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (5), by striking “and” at the  
7 end;

8 (2) by redesignating paragraph (6) as para-  
9 graph (7); and

10 (3) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-  
11 lowing new paragraph:

12 “(6) is not a person with disabilities, as such  
13 term is defined in section 3(b)(3)(E) of the United  
14 States Housing Act of 1937 (42 U.S.C.  
15 1437a(b)(3)(E)); and”.
