- 7 ment an earmark for any entity other than a Department

- 1 of Energy laboratory with respect to the Energy Efficiency
- 2 and Renewable Energy program.
- 3 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 4 This Act shall apply to appropriations Acts for fiscal
- 5 year 2007 or any subsequent fiscal year.
