3 **SECTION 1. PROGRAM FOR PROVISION OF CHIROPRACTIC**
4 **CARE AND SERVICES TO VETERANS.**

5 Section 204(c) of the Department of Veterans Affairs
6 Health Care Programs Enhancement Act of 2001 (38
7 U.S.C. 1710 note) is amended—

1 (1) by inserting “(1)” before “The program”;

2 and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following new

4 paragraph:

5 “(2) The program shall be carried out at not fewer

6 than 75 medical centers by not later than December 31,

7 2008, and at all medical centers by not later than Decem-

8 ber 31, 2010.”.

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
