A BILL

For the relief of Irma Diaz, Luis Diaz, Jr., and Monica
Diaz.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION TO REMAIN TEMPORARILY IN**
4 **THE UNITED STATES FOR IRMA DIAZ, LUIS**
5 **DIAZ, JR., AND MONICA DIAZ.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
7 rity shall stay removal or deportation of Irma Diaz, Luis
8 Diaz, Jr., and Monica Diaz from the United States and
9 permit them to remain temporarily in the United States
10 notwithstanding section 237(a) of the Immigration and
11 Nationality Act.

1 (b) APPLICATION TO PREVIOUSLY KNOWN
2 GROUNDS.—The stay of removal or deportation under
3 subsection (a) shall apply only to grounds for removal or
4 deportation of which the Department of State or the De-
5 partment of Homeland Security had knowledge before the
6 date of the enactment of this Act.

7 (c) DURATION.—The stay of removal or deportation
8 under subsection (a) shall be effective during the period
9 beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act and
10 ending on the date that is 60 days after a final decision
11 is rendered with respect to the application for asylum filed
12 by Luis Diaz, Sr., the father of Luis Diaz, Jr. and Monica
13 Diaz and spouse of Irma Diaz.

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
