2	ED THE MARINERS MEDAL TO BE PROVIDED
3	PRIORITY FOR DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
4	AFFAIRS HEALTH CARE ON SAME BASIS AS
5	VETERANS AWARDED THE PURPLE HEART.
6	(a) Health Care Priority.—Sections 1705(a)(3)
7	and 1710(a)(2)(D) of title 38, United States Code, are
8	amended by inserting "or the Mariners Medal" after "the
9	Purple Heart".
10	(b) Mariners Medal Defined.—Section 1701 of
11	such title is amended by adding at the end the following
12	new paragraph:
13	"(11) The term 'Mariners Medal' means the medal
14	authorized to be awarded pursuant to section 3 of the Act
15	of May 10, 1943, entitled 'An Act to provide for the
16	issuance of devices in recognition of the services of mer-
17	chant sailors' (Public Law 52 of the 78th Congress), to
18	any person, who while serving on any vessel in the Amer-
19	ican merchant marine during the World War II period,
20	was wounded, suffered physical injury, or suffered through
21	dangerous exposure as a result of an act of an enemy of
22	the United States.".
