## A BILL

To make Celina, Ohio, eligible for certain rural development  
loans and grants.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF CELINA, OHIO, FOR CERTAIN**  
4 **RURAL DEVELOPMENT LOANS AND GRANTS.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the city  
6 of Celina, Ohio, shall be considered to be a rural area for  
7 purposes of the programs operated under paragraphs (1),  
8 (2), (6), (22), and (24) of section 306(a), section 306A,  
9 and subtitle E of the Consolidated Farm and Rural Devel-  
10 opment Act, until the population of the city exceeds 150  
11 percent of the greatest population an area could have and

- 1 (in the absence of this section) still be considered a rural
- 2 area for purposes of the program involved.
