To amend title 5, United States Code, to establish certain protections for preference eligibles selected for involuntary geographic reassignment.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Reassign-
- 5 ment Protection Act".

1	SEC. 2. PROTECTIONS FOR PREFERENCE ELIGIBLES SE-
2	LECTED FOR INVOLUNTARY GEOGRAPHIC
3	REASSIGNMENT.
4	(a) In General.—Section 3502 of title 5, United
5	States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
6	lowing:
7	"(g)(1) A preference eligible may not be involuntarily
8	separated for failing to accept a directed reassignment to
9	a position outside the commuting area of the preference
10	eligible concerned or to accompany a position outside of
11	such area pursuant to a transfer of function unless such
12	preference eligible—
13	"(A) receives written notice of the reassignment
14	(together with notice of the rights afforded by sub-
15	paragraph (B) and paragraph (2)) at least 30 days
16	before the effective date of the reassignment; and
17	"(B) is allowed to elect to have the selection of
18	employees for release conducted in the same manner
19	as would be required under subsection (a) in the
20	case of a reduction in force.
21	"(2) A preference eligible involuntarily separated in
22	the circumstances described in paragraph (1) (in the mat-
23	ter before subparagraph (A) thereof) is entitled to appeal
24	to the Merit Systems Protection Board under section 7701
25	any failure to comply with the requirements of this sub-
26	section.

- 1 "(3) For purposes of this subsection, the term 'pref-
- 2 erence eligible' includes a preference eligible serving in or
- 3 under the United States Postal Service.".
- 4 (b) Technical Amendment.—The first sentence of
- 5 section 3501(b) of such title is amended by striking "and
- 6 section 3504" and inserting "section 3502(g)(3), and sec-
- 7 tion 3504".
