To authorize appropriations for the Housing Assistance Council.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

**3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** 

4 This Act may be cited as the "Housing Assistance5 Council Authorization Act of 2006".

## 6 SEC. 2. ASSISTANCE TO HOUSING ASSISTANCE COUNCIL.

7 (a) USE.—The Secretary of Housing and Urban De8 velopment may provide financial assistance to the Housing
9 Assistance Council for use by such Council to develop the
10 ability and capacity of community-based housing develop11 ment organizations to undertake community development

and affordable housing projects and programs in rural 1 2 areas. Assistance provided by the Secretary under this sec-3 tion may be used by the Housing Assistance Council for— 4 (1) technical assistance, training, support, and 5 advice to develop the business and administrative ca-6 pabilities of rural community-based housing develop-7 ment organizations; 8 (2) loans, grants, or other financial assistance 9 to rural community-based housing development orga-10 nizations to carry out community development and 11 affordable housing activities for low- and moderate-12 income families; and 13 (3) such other activities as may be determined 14 by the Housing Assistance Council. 15 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is authorized to be appropriated for financial assistance 16 under this section for the Housing Assistance Council— 17 18 (1) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2007; and 19 (2) \$15,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2008, 20 2009, 2010, 2011, and 2012.
