Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. REQUIRING CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL FOR

IMPLEMENTATION OF A SEVERITY-ADJUSTED

INPATIENT PROSPECTIVE PAYMENT SYSTEM

FOR RURAL HOSPITALS UNDER THE MEDI
CARE PROGRAM.

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-

retary of Health and Human Services may not implement

- 1 a severity-adjusted inpatient prospective payment system
- 2 under section 1886(d) of the Social Security Act (42
- 3 U.S.C. 1395ww(d)), including that contained in the pro-
- 4 posed rule published in the Federal Register on April 25,
- 5 2006 (71 Federal Register 23995), for hospitals located
- 6 in rural areas (as defined for purposes of such section)
- 7 without the explicit approval of Congress.
