A BILL

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Community
- 5 Health Enhancement Act of 2006".

4	(a) Requirement.—Immediately upon enactment of
5	any law making appropriations for fiscal year 2007 that
6	appropriates or otherwise makes available any funds for
7	the National Endowment for the Arts, the Secretary of
8	the Treasury shall (subject to subsection (b)) transfer to
9	the "Medical Services" appropriation account of the De-
