A BILL

To limit the noncompetitive award of Federal contracts in response to major disasters and emergencies, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Competitiveness in
- 5 Contracting Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON NONCOMPETITIVE AWARD OF CON-
- 7 TRACTS DURING MAJOR DISASTERS AND
- 8 EMERGENCIES.
- 9 (a) Limitation.—In awarding a contract to procure
- 10 property or services in connection with a major disaster

- 1 or emergency, if the head of an executive agency awards
- 2 the contract using procedures other than competitive pro-
- 3 cedures pursuant to the exception provided in section
- 4 303(c)(2) of the Federal Property and Administrative
- 5 Services Act of 1949 (41 U.S.C. 253(c)(2)), the contract
- 6 may be for a period of not greater than 90 days, with
- 7 an option to extend the contract for 1 additional 90-day
- 8 period.
- 9 (b) Justification for Additional Exten-
- 10 SIONS.—A contract described in subsection (a) may be ex-
- 11 tended beyond the periods allowed under that subsection
- 12 if the head of the executive agency concerned submits to
- 13 Congress in writing a justification explaining the rationale
- 14 for the extension of the contract.
- 15 (c) Encouragement of Competition.—The head
- 16 of each executive agency should encourage the use of com-
- 17 petitive procedures in the award of contracts in connection
- 18 with a major disaster or emergency.
- 19 (d) Major Disaster and Emergency.—In this
- 20 section, the terms "major disaster" and "emergency" have
- 21 the meanings provided in section 102 of the Robert T.
- 22 Stafford Disaster and Emergency Assistance Act (42)
- 23 U.S.C. 5122).
