3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Snoqualmie Pass Land
- 5 Conveyance Act of 2006".

1SEC. 2. LAND CONVEYANCE, NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM2LAND, KITTITAS COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

3 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—The Secretary of Agriculture shall convey, without consideration, to the King 4 5 and Kittitas Counties Fire District #51 of King and Kittitas Counties, Washington (in this section referred to 6 7 as the "District"), all right, title, and interest of the 8 United States in and to a parcel of National Forest Sys-9 tem land in Kittitas County, Washington, consisting of approximately three acres within the NW1/4,SW1/4,SE1/4 of 10 11 section 4, township 22 north, range 11 east, Willamette 12 meridian, for the purpose of permitting the District to use 13 the parcel as a site for a new Snoqualmie Pass fire and rescue station. 14

15 (b) REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—If the Secretary de-16 termines at any time that the real property conveyed under subsection (a) is not being used in accordance with 17 the purpose of the conveyance specified in such subsection, 18 19 all right, title, and interest in and to the property shall 20 revert, at the option of the Secretary, to the United States, 21 and the United States shall have the right of immediate 22 entry onto the property. Any determination of the Sec-23 retary under this subsection shall be made on the record 24 after an opportunity for a hearing.

25 (c) SURVEY.—If necessary, the exact acreage and
26 legal description of the lands to be conveyed under sub•HR 5999 IH

section (a) shall be determined by a survey satisfactory
 to the Secretary. The cost of a survey shall be borne by
 the District.

4 (d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
5 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi6 tions in connection with the conveyance under subsection
7 (a) as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the
8 interests of the United States.
