## A BILL

To amend the Reclamation Safety of Dams Act of 1978 to authorize improvements for the security of dams and other facilities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADDITIONAL AUTHORIZATION FOR IMPROVE-**  
4 **MENTS TO SITE SECURITY.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Reclamation Safety of Dams  
6 Act of 1978 (Public Law 95–578) is amended—

7 (1) in section 2, by inserting “and site security”  
8 after “structural safety”;

1           (2) in section 3, by inserting “and site security”  
2 after “dam safety”;

3           (3) in section 4(c)—

4                 (A) by inserting “and all costs incurred for  
5 building and site security activities (including  
6 facility fortifications, operation, maintenance  
7 and replacement of such fortifications, and  
8 guards and patrols, as identified in the Bureau  
9 of Reclamation’s Report to Congress dated Feb-  
10 ruary 2006,)” after “for safety purposes”;

11                 (B) by inserting after subsection (c)(2) the  
12 following:

13                 “(3) In the case of the Central Valley Project  
14 of California, dam safety and site security costs allo-  
15 cated to irrigation and municipal and industrial  
16 water service shall be collected by the Secretary ex-  
17 clusively through inclusion of these costs in the oper-  
18 ation and maintenance, rates, capital water rates, or  
19 both, and shall not be segregated from other project  
20 operation, maintenance, or capital costs for separate  
21 allocation or repayment.”; and

22                 (C) by redesignating paragraphs (3) and  
23 (4) as paragraphs (4) and (5), respectively; and

1           (4) in section 4(e), by inserting “or site security  
2           measure,” after “of the modification” each place it  
3           appears.

4 **SEC. 2. REPORTS TO CONGRESS.**

5           The Reclamation Safety of Dams Act of 1978 is  
6           amended as follows:

7           (1) In section 5—

8                   (A) by striking “There are hereby” insert-  
9                   ing the following:

10           “(a) There are hereby”;

11                   (B) by striking “Act:” and inserting  
12                   “Act.”;

13                   (C) by striking “Provided, that no funds”  
14                   and inserting the following:

15           “(b) No funds”;

16                   (D) by inserting “the cause of which re-  
17                   sults from new hydrologic or seismic data or  
18                   changes in the state-of-the-art criteria deemed  
19                   necessary for site security or structural safety  
20                   purposes,” after “an existing dam under this  
21                   Act,” and before “prior to 30 calendar days.”;  
22                   and

23                   (E) by adding at the end the following:

24           “(c) The Secretary shall transmit an annual report  
25           to the Committee on Resources of the House of Represent-

1 atives and the Committee Energy and Natural Resources  
2 of the Senate on building and site security measures un-  
3 dertaken pursuant to this Act during the fiscal year cov-  
4 ered by the report. The report shall include—

5           “(1) a summary of Federal and non-Federal ex-  
6 penditures for the fiscal year; and

7           “(2) information relating to a 5-year plan for  
8 building and site security measures undertaken pur-  
9 suant to this Act, detailed to show pre-September  
10 11, 2001, and post September 11, 2001, costs for  
11 the building and site security measures.”.

12           (2) In section 5A—

13           (A) by inserting “or site security meas-  
14 ure,” after “modification” each place it ap-  
15 pears;

16           (B) in subsection (c)(3), by striking “The  
17 response” and inserting “When a modification  
18 is the result of new hydrologic or seismic data  
19 or changes in the state-of-the-art criteria  
20 deemed necessary for structural safety pur-  
21 poses, the response”;

22           (C) by striking “section 5” and inserting  
23 “section 5(b)”; and

- 1 (D) in subsection (d), by inserting “or site
- 2 security” after “dam safety”.
