- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE UNITED STATES
- 4 POSTAL SERVICE MEMORIAL FUND.
- 5 There is hereby established in the Treasury of the
- 6 United States a fund to be known as the "United States
- 7 Postal Service Memorial Fund" (hereinafter in this Act

- 1 referred to as the "Fund"), into which there shall be de-
- 2 posited all amounts received by the United States Postal
- 3 Service which are designated for deposit into the Fund.
