Mr. BEAUPREZ introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to ensure that the National Driver Registry includes certain information.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL DRIVER REGISTRY ENHANCEMENT.**

4 (a) INFORMATION REGARDING CERTAIN DRIVERS.—

5 Section 30304(b)(1) of title 49, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subparagraph (C) as sub-
8 paragraph (D);

9 (2) by striking “and” at the end of subpara-
10 graph (B); and

1 (3) by inserting after subparagraph (A) the fol-
2 lowing:

3 “(C) information that specifies if an indi-
4 vidual has been convicted in the previous 10
5 years under the laws of the State of operating
6 a motor vehicle under the influence of, or im-
7 paired by, alcohol or a controlled substance;”.

8 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by sub-
9 section (a) shall apply to a conviction described in section
10 30304(b)(1)(C) of title 49, United States Code, that oc-
11 curs on or after the date of enactment of this Act.

12 **SEC. 2. ACCESS TO REGISTER INFORMATION.**

13 Section 30305(b) of title 49, United States Code, is
14 amended by adding at the end the following:

15 “(12) A State or local prosecutor and district
16 attorney may request the chief driver licensing offi-
17 cial of a State to obtain information under sub-
18 section (a) about an individual who is under inves-
19 tigation for a traffic related offense. A prosecutor
20 and a district attorney may receive the informa-
21 tion.”.
