A BILL

To provide children born in the United States with the same citizenship and immigration status as their mothers.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "End Birth Citizenship
- 5 to Illegal Aliens Act of 2006".

1	SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRA-
2	TION STATUS FOR A CHILD BORN IN THE
3	UNITED STATES BASED ON CITIZENSHIP AND
4	IMMIGRATION STATUS OF THE CHILD'S
5	MOTHER.
6	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a child
7	born in the United States (as defined in section
8	101(a)(38) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
9	U.S.C. 1101(a)(38)) shall have the same citizenship and
10	immigration status at birth as the citizenship and immi-
11	gration status of the child's mother.
