# A BILL

To expand the oversight and accounting authority of the Office of the Special Inspector General for Iraq Reconstruction over funds appropriated for the Iraq Security Forces Fund and to restore a termination date for the Office based on the percentage of expenditures from the Iraq Relief and Reconstruction Fund and the Iraq Security Forces Fund.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

#### SECTION 1. OFFICE OF THE SPECIAL INSPECTOR GENERAL

- 2 FOR IRAQ RECONSTRUCTION.
- 3 (a) Additional Duties of Office.—For purposes
- 4 of carrying out the duties of the Special Inspector General
- 5 for Iraq Reconstruction under section 3001(f) of the
- 6 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act for Defense
- 7 and for the Reconstruction of Iraq and Afghanistan, 2004
- 8 (Public Law 108–106; 117 Stat. 1235; 5 U.S.C. App.,
- 9 note to section 8G of Public Law 95–452), any United
- 10 States funds appropriated or otherwise made available for
- 11 fiscal year 2007 for the Iraq Security Forces Fund pursu-
- 12 ant to the authorization of appropriations in section 1516
- 13 of the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act
- 14 for Fiscal Year 2007 (Public Law 109–364; 120 Stat.
- 15 2440), shall be deemed to be amounts appropriated or oth-
- 16 erwise made available to the Iraq Relief and Reconstruc-
- 17 tion Fund.
- 18 (b) Termination Provision.—Subsection (o) of
- 19 section 3001 of the Emergency Supplemental Appropria-
- 20 tions Act for Defense and for the Reconstruction of Iraq
- 21 and Afghanistan, 2004 (Public Law 108–106; 117 Stat.
- 22 1234; 5 U.S.C. App., note to section 8G of Public Law
- 23 95–452), is amended to read as follows:
- 24 "(o) Termination.—The Office of the Inspector
- 25 General shall terminate on the date that is 10 months

- after the date, as determined by the Secretary of State
  and the Secretary of Defense, on which both—

  "(1) 80 percent of the amounts appropriated or
  otherwise made available to the Iraq Relief and Reconstruction Fund by chapter 2 of title II of this Act
  and any subsequent law have been expended; and

  "(2) 80 percent of the amounts appropriated or
  - "(2) 80 percent of the amounts appropriated or otherwise made available to the Iraq Security Forces Fund pursuant to the authorization of appropriations in section 1516 of the John Warner National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2007 (Public Law 109–364; 120 Stat. 2440) and any subsequent law have been expended.".

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
