 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Geneva Distinctive3 Emblems Protection Act of 2006".

4 SEC. 2. GENEVA DISTINCTIVE EMBLEMS.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 33 of title 18, United
6 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 706 the
7 following:

8 "§ 706a. Geneva distinctive emblems

9 "(a) Whoever wears or displays the sign of the Red 10 Crescent or the Third Protocol Emblem (the Red Crystal), 11 or any insignia colored in imitation thereof for the fraudulent purpose of inducing the belief that he is a member 12 13 of or an agent for an authorized national society using the Red Crescent or the Third Protocol Emblem, the 14 International Committee of the Red Cross, or the Inter-15 national Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Soci-16 eties shall be fined under this title or imprisoned not more 17 18 than 6 months, or both.

19 "(b) Except as set forth in section (c) and (d), who-20 ever, whether a corporation, association, or person, uses 21 the emblem of the Red Crescent or the Third Protocol 22 Emblem on a white ground or any sign or insignia made 23 or colored in imitation thereof or the designations 'Red 24 Crescent' or 'Third Protocol Emblem' shall be fined under 25 this title or imprisoned not more than 6 months, or both.

1	"(c) The following may use such emblems and des-
2	ignations consistent with the Geneva Conventions of Au-
3	gust 12, 1949, and, if applicable, the Additional Protocols:
4	"(1) Authorized national societies that are
5	members of the International Federation of Red
6	Cross and Red Crescent Societies and their duly au-
7	thorized employees and agents.
8	"(2) The International Committee of the Red
9	Cross and its duly authorized employees and agents.
10	"(3) The International Federation of Red Cross
11	and Red Crescent Societies and its duly authorized
12	employees and agents.
13	"(4) The sanitary and hospital authorities of
14	the armed forces of State Parties to the Geneva
15	Conventions of August 12, 1949.
16	"(d) This section does not make unlawful the use of
17	any such emblem, sign, insignia, or words which was law-
18	ful on or before December 8, 2005, if such use would not
19	appear in time of armed conflict to confer the protections
20	of the Geneva Conventions of August 12, 1949, and, if
21	applicable, the Additional Protocols.
22	"(e) A violation of this section or section 706 may
23	be enjoined at the civil suit of the Attorney General.".
24	(b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
25	at the beginning of chapter 33 of title 18, United States

- 1 Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to
- 2 section 706 the following new item:

"706a. Geneva distinctive emblems.".
