## A BILL

To amend title 17, United States Code, with respect to settlement agreements reached with respect to litigation involving certain secondary transmissions of superstations and network stations.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO 17 U.S.C. 119.**

4       Section 119(a)(7)(B) of title 17, United States Code,  
5       is amended by inserting after clause (ii) the following:

6               “The court may, at any time, approve a settle-  
7               ment agreement executed after December 1,

1           2006, by 1 or more plaintiffs and 1 or more de-  
2           fendants in connection with litigation that re-  
3           sulted in the entry of an injunction under  
4           clause (i) or (ii) of this subparagraph, and may  
5           modify such injunction accordingly.”.
