3 SECTION 1. MORGANZA TO THE GULF OF MEXICO, LOU-4 ISIANA.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army may
6 carry out the following elements of the project for hurri7 cane and storm damage reduction, Morganza to the Gulf

of Mexico, Louisiana, substantially in accordance with the
 report of the Chief of Engineers, dated August 23, 2002,
 and the supplemental report dated July 22, 2003:

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(1) The Houma Lock feature of the project.

5 (2) The Reach H-3, Reach J-2, Bush Canal
6 floodgate, Point aux Chene floodgate, Reach H-2,
7 Reach J-3, Reach J-1, and Placid Canal structural
8 elements of the project

9 (b) CREDIT.—The Secretary shall credit toward the 10 non-Federal share of the cost of the project elements the 11 cost of design and construction work carried out by the 12 non-Federal interest before the date of the partnership 13 agreement for the project elements if the Secretary determines that the work is integral to the project elements. 14 15 (c) OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE.—The operation, maintenance, repair, rehabilitation, and replacement of 16 17 the Houma Navigation Canal lock complex and the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway floodgate features that provide for 18 19 inland waterway transportation shall be a Federal respon-20sibility, in accordance with the feasibility report dated 21 March 2002 and section 102 of the Water Resources De-22 velopment Act of 1986 (33 U.S.C. 2212).

23 (d) NAVIGATIONAL CONSISTENCY.—The Secretary
24 shall maintain the Houma Navigation Canal at dimensions
