- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.
- 4 The United States courthouse located at 2500 Tulare
- 5 Street in Fresno, California, shall be known and des-
- 6 ignated as the "Robert E. Coyle United States Court-
- 7 house".

1 SEC. 2. REFERENCES.

- 2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
- 3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
- 4 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
- 5 to be a reference to the "Robert E. Coyle United States
- 6 Courthouse".

7 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 8 This Act shall become effective on the day on which
- 9 Robert E. Coyle, a senior judge for the United States Dis-
- 10 trict Court for the Eastern District of California, relin-
- 11 quishes or otherwise ceases to hold a position as a judge
- 12 under Article III of the Constitution.
