Mrs. CAPITO, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3) to authorize funds for Federal-aid highways, highway safety programs, and transit programs, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3) to authorize funds for Federal-
6 aid highways, highway safety programs, and transit pro-
7 grams, and for other purposes. The first reading of the

1 bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
2 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall
3 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed two hours and
4 20 minutes, with two hours and 10 minutes equally di-
5 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
6 ity member of the Committee on Transportation and In-
7 frastructure, including a final period of 10 minutes fol-
8 lowing consideration of the bill for amendment, and 10
9 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman
10 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways
11 and Means. The amendment in the nature of a substitute
12 recommended by the Committee on Transportation and
13 Infrastructure now printed in the bill, modified by the
14 amendment printed in part A of the report of the Com-
15 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution, shall be
16 considered as adopted in the House and in the Committee
17 of the Whole. The bill, as amended, shall be considered
18 as the original bill for the purpose of further amendment
19 under the five-minute rule and shall be considered as read.
20 All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-
21 ed, are waived. No further amendment shall be in order
22 except those printed in part B of the report of the Com-
23 mittee on Rules or except pursuant to a subsequent order
24 of the House. Each amendment in part B may be offered
25 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered

1 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be con-
2 sidered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified
3 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-
4 ponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to
5 amendment or demand for division of the question in the
6 House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of
7 order against amendments in part B are waived. After dis-
8 position of the amendments in part B, the Committee shall
9 rise without motion. No further consideration of the bill
10 shall be in order except pursuant to a subsequent order
11 of the House.
