## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3) to authorize funds for Federal-aid highways, highway safety programs, and transit programs, and for other purposes.

*Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee of the Whole House on the state of the Union for considertation of the bill (H.R. 3) to authorize funds for Federalaid highways, highway safety programs, and transit programs, and for other purposes. The first reading of the

bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against 1 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall 2 3 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed two hours and 4 20 minutes, with two hours and 10 minutes equally di-5 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Transportation and In-6 7 frastructure, including a final period of 10 minutes fol-8 lowing consideration of the bill for amendment, and 10 9 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chairman 10 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and Means. The amendment in the nature of a substitute 11 12 recommended by the Committee on Transportation and 13 Infrastructure now printed in the bill, modified by the amendment printed in part A of the report of the Com-14 15 mittee on Rules accompanying this resolution, shall be considered as adopted in the House and in the Committee 16 17 of the Whole. The bill, as amended, shall be considered 18 as the original bill for the purpose of further amendment 19 under the five-minute rule and shall be considered as read. 20All points of order against provisions in the bill, as amend-21 ed, are waived. No further amendment shall be in order 22 except those printed in part B of the report of the Com-23 mittee on Rules or except pursuant to a subsequent order of the House. Each amendment in part B may be offered 24 25 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered

1 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified 2 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-3 ponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to 4 5 amendment or demand for division of the question in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of 6 7 order against amendments in part B are waived. After disposition of the amendments in part B, the Committee shall 8 9 rise without motion. No further consideration of the bill shall be in order except pursuant to a subsequent order 10 11 of the House.
