# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2863) making appropriations for the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2863) making appropriations for  
6 the Department of Defense for the fiscal year ending Sep-

1   tember 30, 2006, and for other purposes. The first reading  
2   of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order  
3   against consideration of the bill are waived. General de-  
4   bate shall be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one  
5   hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman and  
6   ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropria-  
7   tions. After general debate the bill shall be considered for  
8   amendment under the five-minute rule. All points of order  
9   against provisions in the bill for failure to comply with  
10   clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. During consideration of  
11   the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee  
12   of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the  
13   basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has  
14   caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional  
15   Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule  
16   XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as  
17   read. When the committee rises and reports the bill back  
18   to the House with a recommendation that the bill do pass,  
19   the previous question shall be considered as ordered on  
20   the bill and amendments thereto to final passage without  
21   intervening motion except one motion to recommit with  
22   or without instructions.
