Mrs. CAPITO, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3010) making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3010) making appropriations for

1 the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services,
2 and Education, and Related Agencies for the fiscal year
3 ending September 30, 2006, and for other purposes. The
4 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
5 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-
6 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
7 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-
8 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
9 Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be con-
10 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points
11 of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply
12 with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived except for section
13 511. During consideration of the bill for amendment, the
14 Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord pri-
15 ority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member
16 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the
17 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that
18 purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed
19 shall be considered as read. When the Committee rises and
20 reports the bill back to the House with a recommendation
21 that the bill do pass, the previous question shall be consid-
22 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to
23 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-
24 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
